Ethical Trade or ethical sourcing, as it is sometimes called, can mean different things to different people.

In the late 1990s, companies selling food and clothing to UK consumers were coming under increasing pressure - from trade unions, non-governmental organisations and consumers - to ensure decent working conditions for the people who produced the goods they sold. Such companies typically responded by adopting a code of practice setting out minimum labour standards that they expected their suppliers to comply with. But what should minimum labour standards cover? And how can they be implemented effectively? What does it mean being "ethical"? What is involved? How do you go about it? Many companies who adopted such code soon found that they did not have the necessary experience and skills to answer these questions alone.
